This course will enable students to complete the education requirements and the Professional Portfolio required by the Council for Professional Recognition.

It consists of 10 modules and requires a minimum of 120 clock hours of study for completion. Requirements of each module include seminar attendance and completion of study assignments. The course is designed for self-motivated students.

Cost of complete course:

and \$200.00 Registration Fee

(Registration fee due September 5; \$250.00 of course fee due September 18; \$250.00 due January 8)

Dates:

Orientation – September 5

Classes – September 18, October 3, 16, & 30, November 13,
December 4, January 8 & 22, February 5 & 20, March 5, & 19, April 3 (Tuesday)

Requirements of student:

- Meet CDA candidate eligibility requirements as defined by the Council for Early Childhood Recognition
- For each module, attend the seminar(s) and complete self-study assignments by the designated date
- Understand that only one absence is permitted without prior approval from the program administrator
- Complete the on-line Council for Professional Development application process and pay a \$425 application fee to the Council
- Find a Professional Development Specialist and schedule your Verification Visit
- Schedule your CDA Exam at a Pearson VUE Online testing center

The class is designed to have students ready to apply for CDA certification by April 15, 2018
